KSI Concerts- Music in the Round

Music in the Round will be returning to perform in Barking Broadway Theatre. The concerts, suitable for Reception and Key Stage 1 children are in June and booking is now open. These concerts are popular and book up fast! This year the team will perform the Chimpanzees of Happy Town. Each concert on Thursday the 6th of June lasts 45 minutes and schools can choose between the 10.45 morning delivery or afternoon 1.30 delivery. The cost per pupil for the concert is £5 and any accompanying adult comes for free.





GRADE 4+ LSO DISCOVERY

Create composition project will take place in Richard Alibon ARP. LSO Activate rehearsals continue and CMS pupils will participate in March. We will host East London Academy string development workshop for pupils of Grade 4 and above. The workshop will be led by four members of the LSO string sections, and will conclude with a short concert for parents and friends.

KS3-WE COMPOSE

Music in the Round will commence the WeCompose for KS3 pupils in Dagenham Park Community School, Sydney Russell School & The Warren School. Pupils will work with professional composers and a string quartet. CPD will be given to teachers, an Introductory Concert and school visits are all included for all. In this programme, professional composers who will work alongside school music teachers to help the pupils produce compositions that will be performed at the culmination concert at the Broadway Theatre on 1st July.

CELEBRATIONS

The annual CMS Staff Christmas concerts took place in schools over seven days from the 12th December to 20th December. Twenty Five concerts were given in schools including Primary, Junior, Infants, and Special Schools. Our nineteen piece orchestra made from CMS staff and five CMS alumni. The concerts included popular and seasonal music and were interactive with pupils having the opportunity to sing songs including Taylor Swift (Shake it Off) and George Michael (Last Christmas) which was the current chart No. 1.

The pupils were entertained with information on the instruments and the music performed and they participated in rhythm and conducting games. The questions asked at the end of each concert certainly showed their enthusiasm for the music performed to them.

The three concerts at Trinity School included a performance with the CMS staff orchestra by the Trinity Clarinet group in Last Christmas specially arranged for the occasion by their clarinet teacher.

Four pupils in the group have been playing since their WCET lessons in the school and are now in Y12 & Y13. One of the clarinet group had just completed his Grade 3 ABRSM clarinet exam and passed with 115/150, a fantastic achievement. The pupil was thrilled to find out his result on the day that he was performing with the CMS Orchestra at his school.
